The Rebel wrestling team finished the season with an 8-9 overall dual record and a 4-5 Western Valley Conference dual record. The Rebels featured many high tournament finishes including 2nd at Kingsley-Pierson, 3rd at West Sioux and South Sioux City and a 4th place finish at the Class 1A Sectional at Tri-Center, Neola. The Rebels finished the season with 7 wrestlers winning at least 21 matches, 4 wrestlers winning at least 30 matches and 1 wrestler winning over 40 matches.

Some highlights included 3 wrestlers advancing to the Class 1A District Tournament with top 2 places at the sectional tournament. These wrestlers were Zach Ulven, Austin Mead and Jacob Becker.
